SACRAMENTAL CHATECHETICAL PROGRAMMES (2010)

The Holy Rosary offers a programme to provide Catechetical instruction to children. Parents whose children do not attend Catholic schools but would like their children to attend the programme and receive the Sacraments are to:

1. Attend a Parents' Information evening at the Parish Centre
2. Enrol their children by submitting a completed registration form
3. Ensure their children attend all education sessions
4. Organize for their children to receive the Sacrament

No classes are conducted over the school holidays.

First Holy Communion and Confirmation

First Holy Communion (Children in Grade 4)

- Parents' Information evening : 7pm Wed 26 May 2010
- Catechetical instruction: Each Wed (over 10 weeks) starting 4 March 2010 from 4pm to 5pm (Parish Centre)
- First Holy Communion to be held at the 9:30am Mass on Sunday 27 June 2010.

Confirmation (Children in Grades 6 and 7)

- Parents' Information evening : 7pm Wed 28 April 2010
- Catechetical instruction: Each Wed (over 10 weeks) starting 4 March 2010 from 4pm to 5pm (Parish Centre)
- Confirmation to be administered at the 6:30pm Mass on 20 May 2010, the Thursday before Pentecost Sunday.

First Reconciliation (Children in Grade 3)

- Parents' Information evening : 7pm Wed 20 October 2010 at the Parish Centre
- Children in Grade 3 (who do not attend Catholic schools) who intend to make their first Reconciliation are to attend two, ten-week modules:
 - "Introduction to the Sacraments" each Wed, starting 18 August 2010 from 4pm to 5pm (Parish Centre) for 10 weeks
 - "Sacrament of Reconciliation" each Wed at the Parish Centre for 10 weeks
- First reconciliation service to begin at 10am, Sat 6 November 2010.
